

Affective and Activist Citizen Journalism: The Case of Turkey

In this study, we will examine the activist citizen journalism concept based on contemporary social movements and alternative media theories particularly the practices will occur during the process of referendum which Turkey is going through to decide whether to accept the constitutional changes against the separation of powers. Such practices came to the fore after Gezi Resistance in Turkey. However; adding a different perspective to the theories we draw on, we are aiming to also include the analysis layer offered by new theoretical and methodological

discussions deemed as “affective turn”. We will evaluate the data gathered through the content created by the activist citizen journalists, autonomous media collectives and citizen journalism networks.
